**Invitation for Expression of Interest – Liver Expert Sub-Committee, KSOTTO**

Dear Doctor,

Kerala State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (K-SOTTO) is established by Government of Kerala as the apex organization in Kerala to regulate the removal, storage and transplantation of human organs and tissues for therapeutic purposes and for the effective enforcement of The Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act 1994 and rules thereunder.

The focus area of operation of the society is the identification of potential donors, retrieval of organs from deceased donors, equitable allocation of organs, create protocols, maintain waitlist registry, standard operating procedures, and to work in tandem with various transplant centers and Non-Transplant Organ Retrieval centers in the private and public sector.

In order to guide the organization to execute its duties, Kerala State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (KSOTTO) has established specific Expert Committees for clinical guidance, development of SOPs, and system improvements.

In this context, KSOTTO invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified and experienced Gastroenterologists and Surgical Gastroenterologists as Members of the KSOTTO Liver Expert Sub-Committee.

**Roles and Responsibilities:**

Members of the Liver Expert Sub-Committee will provide expert guidance on matters pertaining to practices on liver transplantation, policy inputs, system-level improvements, case specific dilemmas etc. The role requires an approximate commitment of 2 hours per month.

**Eligibility:**

- DM/DNB in Gastroenterology
- MCh/DNB in Surgical Gastroenterology
- Or equivalent/higher qualification

- Minimum 10 years of professional experience in India or abroad upon completion of the aforesaid qualification and involved in organ transplant related professional responsibility

**Terms of Engagement:**

- This is an honorary (unpaid) position
- Members will play a critical role in shaping and strengthening the liver transplant ecosystem in the State
- A Certificate of Recognition will be awarded upon successful completion of your service.
- You are free to engage into any other position with any institution or organization while you continue to be a Member of the KSOTTO Liver Expert Sub-Committee.
- You may withdraw your association with KSOTTO at any point of time in the event of any constraints, with prior intimation.

**Interested doctors are requested to submit:**

1. A Letter of Interest addressed to the Executive Director, KSOTTO (maximum 300 words), outlining your motivation to be part of the Liver Expert Sub-Committee focused on the experience in transplant services
2. Updated Curriculum Vitae
3. Copy of your Qualification mentioned in the eligibility criteria.
